

THE SEAFIELD ARMS HOTEL, CULLEN SCOTLAND

Built in 1822 and situated in the beautiful coastal location of Cullen, The Seafield Arms Hotel has been rejuvenated by a ± 1.3 million refurbishment.

After many years of being closed, this adored listed building has undergone a radical transformation whilst retaining its recognised original features and architectural details. Burns Design created the interior space which crosses between typically traditional Scottish aesthetics mixed with accent contemporary elements. Offering, 16- Guest and family suites, a rustic timber clad bar, panelled private dining areas/ meeting rooms, a warm and welcoming restaurant with additional outdoor area and cocktail lounge. Serviced cottage apartments will be joining the hotel amenities in the near future.
